Traits to look for in a life long marriage partner

5) Humor/Patience/Respect

- Never talks anything too seriously (especially ones self)
- Looks for the positive in others
- Will help his or her partner to grow & be fulfilled
- Listens.

6) Family

- Wants a family & is willing to have & raise children if you want a family
- Recognizes family as an extension of ourselves and a true support system. (If from a broken family be extra careful)*.

7) Communication

- Actively works at communicating. Communication takes time & effort and is a life long process*.

8) Behavior

- Moderation with alcohol; no drugs*
- No major funks*.
